PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT

July 3, 2014

Nighttime milling and paving of several Downtown streets will begin on Monday, July 7th and is expected to be completed by Thursday, July 17th. Work will take place between 8:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. each night. The anticipated schedule will be as follows, weather permitting.

Main St Parking Lanes (Elm to Chestnut)... milling 7/7, paving 7/10; street will be closed during work

<u>Fire Department Equipment Bay Ramp</u>..... milling 7/7, paving 7/10; traffic to be maintained by flaggers

<u>Dietz St (Main to Wall) & Wall St.....</u> milling 7/8, paving 7/15; streets will be closed during work

Main St (Elm to Hunt)..... milling 7/8-7/9, paving 7/14 & 7/16; traffic to be maintained by flaggers

Traffic signal loop detectors will also be replaced at the intersections of Main & Dietz and Main & Maple. The project will conclude with restoration of pavement markings.
