It is with profound sadness that I write this letter to our Walton community. This morning, one of our 12th grade students had a medical emergency in the hallway and later died.

Our sincere condolences and thoughts go out to her family and friends.

A student death is a difficult and challenging situation that can generate a high level of anxiety and distress in some students. During this time, as the school community processes the tragic news and copes with grief, we will offer counseling and bereavement support services to all of our students and staff. A team of counselors, school psychologists and trained staff at the middle school and high school will provide support to any students or staff members in need throughout the upcoming days.

Your child may be affected by this tragedy even if he or she did not know the student. I encourage you to talk with your child about what has happened. Discussing thoughts and feelings about this situation is important in helping your child work through his or her grief.
